

Interactive Fun: Dig for a...

Objective:

To teach children (and by extension, adults!) about crops and farm animals by asking them age appropriate trivia questions. With the added incentive of digging for a prizes, children will be lining up!

Set-up:

- **The Quizzing Part**
 - Each child should have the opportunity to be quizzed with a farm-related question before they dig for their prize.
 - Sample trivia questions are available in the Farm Trivia section of the Ag Awareness Tool Kit.
 - If a volunteer is present, they could ask the children trivia questions. If no volunteer is present, trivia questions could be written on flip signs that are fastened to a display board. This will allow families to quiz themselves.
- **The Digging Part**
 - Fill a large container (half barrel, plastic tote, wheelbarrow, etc.) with a mixture of corn and small prizes.
 - Prizes that work well: pencils, erasers.
 - Small shovels could be available to help with digging.
